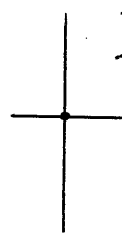

NOTE: Quite a little flow of gas was found in the Second Salt Sand, and a showing of oil in the Weir Sand. All sands were regular and of good quality, but very hard. The well was drilled to a total depth of 2305 feet.
