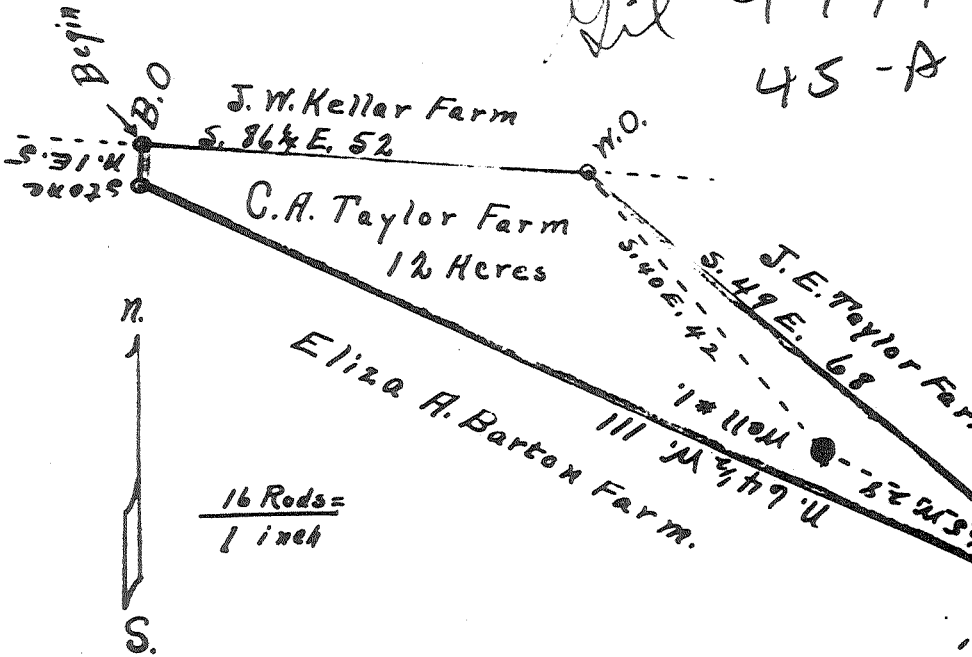

 being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by themselves and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on July 33 and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Well was 1571 feet deep; Filled with clay, one foot dry cement; three feet of clay the feet of clay one foot of dry cement; three feet of clay the with clay to 1512; drove wood plug at 1512; then filled to 1500 feet; Set a permanent bridge at 1381; then filled a non-porous material to 1093; Drove a wooden plug to coal. Second Salt Sand also cement plug at this depth; then filled red clay to 978 20 feet above the first Salt Sand; then drove a wooden plug at 978 and a cement plug at 973 sealing Manner in which coal was plugged: Salt Sand; then filled with non porous material from 949 to 383, bottom of the Cow Run Sand; Drove wood Plug at 383, sealing the hole completely; then filled with non porous material to the surface.
