WELL TO BE PLUGGED

Fill with clay or non-porous material to 10 feet above the hole which is 10 feet above the Fifty Foot Sand, there install a suitable plug.

Then pull the plug to the surface.

After pulling the plug, fill the hole with clay or non-porous material to 10 feet above the Fifty Foot Sand, there install a suitable plug.

Bridge the hole at 140 feet and fill with clay or non-porous material to 130 feet which is 10 feet above the Big Ingot Sand, (in Big Lime) and there install a suitable plug, completely sealing the hole.

Bridge hole at 120 feet and fill with clay or non-porous material to 50 feet which is 10 feet above the First bit sand, and there install a suitable plug, then fill the hole with clay or non-porous material to the top.

NOTE:-

If conditions are encountered which will not permit carrying out the above plan, any variation therefrom will be to the best of the practical method and described in detail.
