Coal was encountered at 1157-1160'.

Oil well. Abandonment reported to Dept. of Mines Oct. 27, 1948.

REMARKS: June 24, 1927. Ran 524' 3" of 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  x 4" liner, 24 jts., in two sections. 1st section, 12 jts., 261' 8"; 2nd section, 12 jts., 262' 7". Perforated joint on bottom section. Nipple and bell collar on top. Middle shoe on bottom of top section. Nipple and bell collar on top and top of liner, 2775', steel line. Tight joint, 5 $\frac{1}{8}$ " , 1000' down. Rig rebuilt July 8, 1921.
